Process for apply for credit & funding for an [Unbound](#) program at the University of Adelaide

Nepal, India & Thailand ONLY

FUNDING AVAILABLE

Thanks to the [Global Learning Travel Grant](#), students completing a credit bearing short program overseas each receive **\$500** from the University of Adelaide.

Students may also be eligible for [OS-HELP](#) funding (up to **\$7998** for Asian destinations or **\$6,665** for outside of Asia).

Selected Unbound programs are supported by a **\$3000** [New Colombo Plan Grant](#) for students participating in programs in Nepal & India.

Who is eligible?

University of Adelaide students travelling to Nepal, India & Thailand (only).

SO YOU'VE APPLIED THROUGH UNBOUND, WHERE TO FROM HERE?

To be eligible for funding from the University of Adelaide, your overseas program must count for credit towards your degree or be contributing to course requirements for the Australian course of study in which you are enrolled.

It is up to your [Faculty Advisor](#) as to whether they will approve some credit for your participation in this program.

To apply for credit, you must:

1. [Contact your Faculty Advisor](#) and ask to discuss your individual Study Plan to confirm you have elective space in your degree to study overseas.
2. Register your program in the Global Learning Application System (GLAS) via the [Study Overseas website](#):

3. Work through all of the questionnaires in your application checklist, clicking 'Submit' at the bottom as you complete each one. There are some questionnaires that you may have to come back to later and submit.
4. Once you have received acceptance from your host provider, you will need to upload a scanned copy to the 03 Host Acceptance Details questionnaire in your GLAS application.

ELIGIBILITY FOR FUNDING

To be eligible for funding, the following questionnaires in your GLAS registration will need to be completed and submitted:

- Credit Eligibility and OS-HELP Verification
- Host Application: Your Host Acceptance Documents
- Confirm your bank details are up to date

GLOBAL LEARNING TRAVEL GRANT

Once the above requirements are met, you will be able to request payment of the \$500 [Global Learning Travel Grant](#). This grant is available to all students completing a credit-bearing short program. To request the Grant, you will need to submit the 'Global Learning Travel Grant (\$500 Request' questionnaire within your GLAS application. Please note, once you are assessed as eligible to receive the Grant funds, it takes 2-3 weeks for the funds to be deposited into your bank account.

OS-HELP LOAN

[OS-HELP](#) is a government loan scheme where eligible students can borrow up to \$6,665 (or \$7,998 for Asian destinations) to undertake some of their course of study overseas. Your OS-HELP loan is added to your accumulated HECS debt.

Along with completing the questionnaires in your GLAS application, you will need to meet the following requirements to be eligible for the loan:

- You're a Commonwealth supported student with 24 units of study successfully completed by the time you go on your program, and have at least 3 units left to complete after you return from your program.
- The study program is considered full-time.
- You're an Australian citizen or a Permanent Humanitarian Visa Holder
- The program is counting for credit towards your degree.

If you meet the eligibility criteria, you may collect an OS-HELP form from Ask Adelaide in Hub Central. Once you have completed and returned your OS- HELP application form and checklist in hard copy to Ask Adelaide, your application will be forwarded to Study Overseas. Please note, once you are assessed as eligible to receive the Grant funds, it takes 3-4 weeks for those funds to be deposited into your account. TRAVEL INSURANCE

[Travel insurance](#) is provided by the University of Adelaide free of charge.

By [registering through GLAS](#), you will be automatically covered by the University's comprehensive health and travel insurance. This insurance covers all of the program dates, and up to 50% of the length of your study program for personal travel outside of the program dates.
